

Hiking in Majorca

The way to **Miramar**

In Miramar times seems to have been stopped.

Route description:

High above the sea on the northwest cliffs of Majorca, between Valldemossa and Deiá, lies the former monastery *Monastir de Miramar*. Initiated by the great Majorcan philosopher and mystic Ramón Llull it was built in the year 1276. Miramar inspired Ramón Llull to new ideas which were revolutionary for his time.

On unpaved ways and sometimes very old stages we go down and we can enjoy here exceptional views of the sea and bizarre rock formations.

In addition we will visit a historic olive oil press and a museum dedicated to Ramón Llull.

Duration: Walking time: about 1.5 to 2 hours.
Total: 4 hours.

Level of difficulty: Easy, on unpaved trails.
Recommended for families (baby in backpacks, children over 5 years).

Equipment: Walking shoes, sun protection (hat, glasses, lotion for sun protection), rain gear, water to drink and a picnic.

Entrance fee: 4 €

Meeting Point: At the parking lot of Miramar, with private cars.
